**4 HABITS OF HUMILITY**

**1. Practice \_\_\_\_\_ to others.**

*“Give preference to one another in honour.” Romans 12:10(NAS)*  
*“Practice playing second fiddle.” (Message)*

*“Don’t push your way to the front . . . put yourself aside and help others get ahead. Don’t be obsessed with getting your own advantage. Forget yourselves long enough to lend a helping hand. Think of yourselves the way Jesus thought of Himself. He was God . . . but He took on the status of a slave . . . an incredibly humbling process. He didn’t claim any special privileges. Instead, He lived a selfless, obedient life...” Philippians 2:3-8(Message)*

*“Be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry.”*

**2. Practice \_\_\_\_\_**

*“Conceited people do not like to be corrected and they never ask for advice.” Proverbs 15:12(GN)*

*“If you reject criticism, you only harm yourself, but if you listen to correction, you grow in understanding.” Proverbs 15:32(NLT)*

*“Pride only leads to arguments.” Proverbs 13:10(NCV)*

**3. Practice \_\_\_\_\_**
